

Indian Walk is happy to help you travel internationally with your pet! We need a lot of information to make the process as smooth as possible. Please confirm your address and phone number in both the country you are traveling to and in America. Let us know what day you are leaving and, if different, what day you are arriving in your destination. We also need to know if you will be moving permanently to the other country, visiting, or transiting through to a different country. Let us know if your pet will be traveling with someone different than you owner as that requires special paperwork.

We will need documentation of Rabies vaccination and, for most countries, microchipping if performed at a different hospital. A number of countries have additional testing and vaccination requirements that may need to be performed well in advance. Please go to https://www.aphis.usda.gov/aphis/pet-travel to confirm exactly what is needed to enter the country and ensure you have plenty of time for all required steps. Be aware, FAVN testing for Rabies typically takes up to two months to get results. If you would like assistance with complicated travel guidelines or making flight reservations for your pet, we recommended working with AE Pets International.

After we complete the examination at your pet's visit, we will send the form electronically directly to the APHIS veterinarian for confirmation. There is a \$38 charge to use this service if no laboratory tests are required. However, the charge is \$121 for countries that require Rabies titers (FAVN testing). This charge is from APHIS, not Indian Walk. The charge pays for use of the electronic service and the APHIS veterinarian's time and expertise. We will need this amount at the health certificate examination visit in addition to our examination charge for the health certificate. Please note that our veterinarians work very hard researching each country's specific requirements. If your pet is unable to go for any reason outside the control of our vets, we are unable to refund the cost.

If your destination country has a green border on the APHIS website, we will be able to send everything electronically. If it has an orange boarder, the state veterinarian will need to mail you a signed and printed copy of the form. You will need to provide a **pre-paid, overnight, return address label** from UPS or FedEx. It is recommended that it is able to be delivered over the weekend as well. You may either provide a printed label (no envelope needed) or email a .pdf file. If you email the label, it must be in .pdf format. Ensure your name is in both the "To" and "From" sections. Do not list either Indian Walk Vet or the APHIS veterinarian; this could result in significant delays or loss of the paperwork by the carrier. The paperwork from APHIS will be sent directly to you, not to the hospital.

We may contact you before your visit if we have any questions or need additional specific information. Each country has different requirements and we may need to discuss the situation or perform tests before your health certificate exam.
